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Sunrise Missions Philosophy

Matthew 28:19-20 tells us "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." This mandate, as well as many others throughout the Old and New Testaments, speaks to us as a Christian people, calling each of us to the mission of expanding God's Kingdom.

At Sunrise United Methodist Church, our mission statement is "Knowing Christ and making Him known. Serving Christ by serving others." John Wesley believed that where Christ was dwelling, personal transformation would follow and then works of love and service would flow. In other words, serving is a reflection of who we are as followers of Christ. In Matthew 25:40, Jesus said, "...Whatever you did for the least of these brothers and sisters of mine you did for me."

Sunrise's missions committee also has a mission, "For every member, a mission," along with a vision to be "Externally focused, internally ablaze." God has an individualized "mission" for everyone that no one else can fulfill. Our responsibility as a missions committee is to provide opportunities and support to each member of our church as they seek to discover their part in serving the community and beyond. Missions is the foundation for spreading the goodness of Jesus Christ. Our greatest power to change the world is released when we come together with an outward vision and become salt and light in to our world.

The purpose of this handbook is to offer a common foundation of philosophy, standards and documentation for Sunrise Short-Term Teams. Its intention is to provide resources for leaders in missions, and while this handbook provides general guidelines, we agree that pastors, missions committee members and trip leaders are led by the Holy Spirit to make wise decisions in circumstances that do not exactly fit the outline found in this handbook.

Now, together, let us strive to be faithful to our mission and vision statements, as well as faithful to our Lord, whose heart for the world far surpasses ours, and who calls us to join Him in this journey of missions.

Critical Elements for a Short-Term Mission Trip

- Spiritual element
 - Involves expanding God's Kingdom
 - Shares the love of Christ through words and/or actions
 - Devotion/study time included in the schedule
 - Opportunity to fellowship with local believers

- Relational element
 - An opportunity to Serve Christ by Serving Others
 - Working alongside local leaders and/or community is essential
 - Maintaining a relationship with local leaders before, during and after trip
 - Group-oriented projects that do not isolate individual members from the rest of the team
 - Partnering with other organizations or missions teams is encouraged

- Challenge
 - Encourage participants to step out of their "comfort zone"
 - The leader will look for opportunities to challenge the team members physically, emotionally, intellectually and/or spiritually

- Meeting a need
 - Define the project and its need in that community
 - Check that the project fits the talents and skills of the potential team, so that we are assured we can complete the project with excellence

Summary of Trip

Trip destination: Haiti

Dates of trip: May 31 – June 8, 2012

Contact/Organization we will partner with: We will be partnering with three different organizations. UMCOR, UMVIM and Eglise Methodist de Haiti. These organizations are working as a team to help rebuild Haiti.

Goals for trip: To build relationships with the Haitian people, to assist with building efforts and to teach VBS.

Type of ministry: We will not know what we will be doing until about 1 month before the trip, and even then it may change once we are on site. We will have the opportunity for construction, teaching VBS, and building relationships.

Type of accommodations: Our accommodations will be cots with a bucket shower. There will be cooks and interpreters assigned to us.

Other info: We will be supporting the efforts of the Methodist Church of Haiti in building community in the areas that they serve. The cooks are fantastic, so don't plan on losing any weight!! A good website to learn basic Creole is BYKI.com. Must be physically able to ride in a bus for 4+ hours and withstand heat and humidity.

Financial Commitments

One of the most intimidating parts of applying for a mission trip can be the financial aspect. However, it is also a chance to allow your church, family, and friends to provide support and encouragement. If you feel like money might be an obstacle to your participation in this trip, please turn in your application and speak to your trip leader regarding your concern.

- The total cost of the trip is \$1,800-2,000 depending on airfare
 The deposit of \$100.00 is due by November 15, 2011 and is non-refundable
 Airfare will be due by February 1, 2012, the amount will be determined during the last 2 weeks of January 2012.
 And the remainder will be due by May 1, 2012
 Airfare is not refundable after purchase, there will be no refunds after final payment
- Fundraisers will be available to help with the cost of the trip. More details will be provided by your team leader
- Your team leader will also provide you with information on writing support letters.

Meeting/Training Commitments

In order to prepare ourselves for the ministry we will be doing, and to create a sense of team unity before leaving, we will meet several times before departing. We ask that you commit to attending 5 out of 7 meetings, with the initial meeting being one of the 5.

- Respect others’ view of Christianity. I recognize that Christianity has many faces around the world.
- Dress appropriately for the host country’s culture.
- Maintain a servant’s attitude toward all nationals and my teammates. I will demonstrate that I am there to serve others and share Christ, while learning and developing relationships.
- Respect the thoughts and ideas of your hosts and team members.
- Refrain from criticism or complaining about the host country or teammates. Respect their culture. Be flexible, and supportive.
- Refrain from any activity that could be construed as a special or romantic interest in a national or teammate.
- Watch my language. Abstain from the use, purchase and possession of alcoholic beverages, tobacco and illegal drugs, before or during trip.
- Keep confidential discussions and personal information shared among team members.
- Remember that I can be released from the team if there is an irresolvable conflict or lack of adherence to this Covenant.

How to Write a Support Letter

Writing a support letter is an easy way to inform your friends, family and acquaintances know about the work God is doing in and through your life, and it offers them an opportunity to partner with you in that work. While it can feel uncomfortable to request assistance, the important thing to keep in mind is that missions work is a mandate for the whole church, and not asking others to give is denying them a chance to serve. A sample outline and support letter have been provided; however, be sure to personalize the letter so that your passion is evident. It is recommended to send your letters out 3 to 4 months before your money is due, in order to give the recipients time to respond. Also, you will need to include the reply form provided so that the finance department of Sunrise will know how to designate the offerings.

Outline

- Intro Paragraph: Start off casual and comfortable...(re)introduce yourself
- Paragraph 2: Explain what is going on in your life and your involvement at Sunrise
- Paragraph 3: Proceed with an explanation of the mission trip
- Paragraph 4: Invite them to be a prayer partner, emphasizing the importance of prayer throughout a trip
- Paragraph 5: Invite them to participate financially, including the amount you need to raise
- Final Paragraph: Thank them for their time and let them know you'll be praying for them. Be sure to make it a "hope to hear from you soon" conclusion that expects some sort of response

Sample Support Letter

Dear _____,

(Intro Paragraph: Start off casual and comfortable...(re)introduce yourself)

Hello! I hope you are well and enjoying the beginnings of summer! For some of you, it's been too long since we've spoken, and others of you I see frequently, but I wanted to intentionally reconnect with all of you, and let you know about some of the great things that are happening in my life.

(Paragraph 2: Explain what is going on in your life and your involvement at Sunrise)

I have been staying busy at work, at school and at Sunrise! The Lord has been blessing me with many opportunities to grow and learn and deepen my faith lately, and one of the opportunities He has presented me with is leading a missions trip to Guatemala.

(Paragraph 3: Proceed with an explanation of the mission trip & long-term goal of ministry relationship)

This coming fall, November 19th – 28th, 15 people from Sunrise and the Colorado Springs area will be visiting Guatemala on a short-term missions trip. We will be partnering with a local church near the capital – Guatemala City – where we plan to get oriented to the country, visit the pediatric ward of a low-income hospital, and serve this particular church in a few specific areas of need. We will also spend a great portion of our time in Guatemala in a more rural area, working alongside several local pastors and their wives, who are currently in the process of expanding their ministries. We hope to serve them and their communities in a variety of ways, from children's programs, to more physical work, to ministering specifically to the pastors and leaders themselves.

(Paragraph 4: Invite to be a prayer partner, emphasizing the importance prayer will play in the success of the trip)

This trip provides an opportunity to meet the physical and spiritual needs of a community that is desperately in need. More than anything, I would value your prayers for our team and those whose lives will be touched by God through us. I believe that God answers prayers, and I'm asking you to pray for safety, good health, smooth travel, financial support and open doors for ministry. Just knowing that you will be praying gives me great courage to step out in faith on this trip!

(Paragraph 5: Invite them to participate financially, including the amount you need to raise)

Beyond prayers, there is another need to be met, for this ministry to be possible. Each member of our group needs to raise \$1200 to cover the total cost of the trip. While this task seems great, I am convinced God has called me and our team to go, and I believe He is calling others to participate in a prayerful and/or financial way as well. Would you consider asking God if He is calling you to play a financial role in this missions opportunity? I pledge to keep you informed of the team's progress and to invite you to a celebration and sharing of photographs, slides, and testimonies upon our return. Donations of any amount are greatly appreciated, tax-deductible and can be sent straight to Sunrise. (See insert for information on where to send donations)
